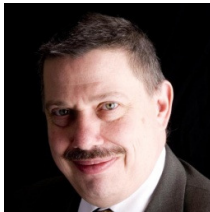

GLYN EVANS

Senior Associate Fellow, University of Warwick Business School

Glyn has over 30 years' experience of working in local government in IT support and management positions and in leading IT-enabled change programmes. Glyn joined Birmingham City Council in a CIO role in 2003 and led the development of the Council's approach to transformational change and, to support that programme, the creation of a joint venture company with the private sector. Glyn became Corporate Director of Business Change with a remit to ensure business transformation was adopted, embedded and implemented across the Council. This included overseeing the development of a comprehensive methodology for supporting business transformation, CHAMPS2.

Glyn was President of the Society of IT Management from May 2011 to April 2012 and is a member of the CIO Council, the Local CIO Council and the Local Government Delivery Council. In July 2011 he commenced a one-year secondment as a Senior Associate Fellow with Warwick Business School, researching innovation and transformation in the public sector.

In July 2012 Glyn will begin a new phase of his career when he leaves the public sector in order to found a startup company, Perarte, focused on building change capacity in public sector organisations.
